 **Supra THC Services**

Kelowna, B.C. – (December 16, 2016): Supra Research and Development (“SUPRA”), a holder of a Health Canada Dealers License enabling testing of Cannabis, and Supra THC Services Inc. (“SUPRATHC”), confirm that SUPRA has signed a termination agreement ending their Joint Venture Agreement (“JV AGREEMENT”) signed Feb 12, 2016 with THC Biomed Ltd., (“THC”) a Health Canada approved MMAR Licenced Producer.

The decision to end the agreement was made by mutual consent and benefit of SUPRA, SUPRATHC and THC.

The company **SUPRATHC** was formed on December 10, 2015 by **SUPRA** and the original **JV AGREEMENT** had **SUPRA** and **THC** share ownership of **SUPRATHC** by **THC** purchasing 80 percent equity stake using a combination of **THC** shares (2.5 Million) and cash (\$600,000). With the termination of the **JV AGREEMENT** ownership of **SUPRATHC** has been transferred to a Holding company DHomeNest Holdings Inc. owned and operated by Dr. Rob O’Brien, the President and CTO of **SUPRA** and the Chief Science Officer (“CSO”) of **SUPRATHC**.

SUPRATHC has applied for an independent Dealers License from Health Canada with a broader scope than the Dealers Licensed held by **SUPRA**. **SUPRATHC** is currently seeking investors and intends to develop into the leading Cannabis Testing Laboratory in Canada. **SUPATHC** also intends to work toward becoming a toll processor for Licensed Producers using a variety of processes including a proprietary process that generates “Oil that is 100 % Cannabis without the addition of any solvents”. All the intellectual Property (IP) developed by **SUPRA** for the Cannabis industry has been transferred to **SUPRATHC**.

Dr. Rob O’Brien stated “We are very excited to move forward with the development of **SUPRATHC**. We are examining many ways to build this company, including a franchise model that could help LP applicants diversify into a profitable horizontal offering. The Cannabis sector is showing tremendous growth potential and we are committed to providing the critical support structures so that LP’s, ACMPR patients and other clients can produce safe and effective products.”

SUPRA and **SUPRATHC** are committed to working cooperatively with **THC** and other stakeholders to elevate the science behind the Cannabis sector, so that Canada becomes the world leader in this sector.
